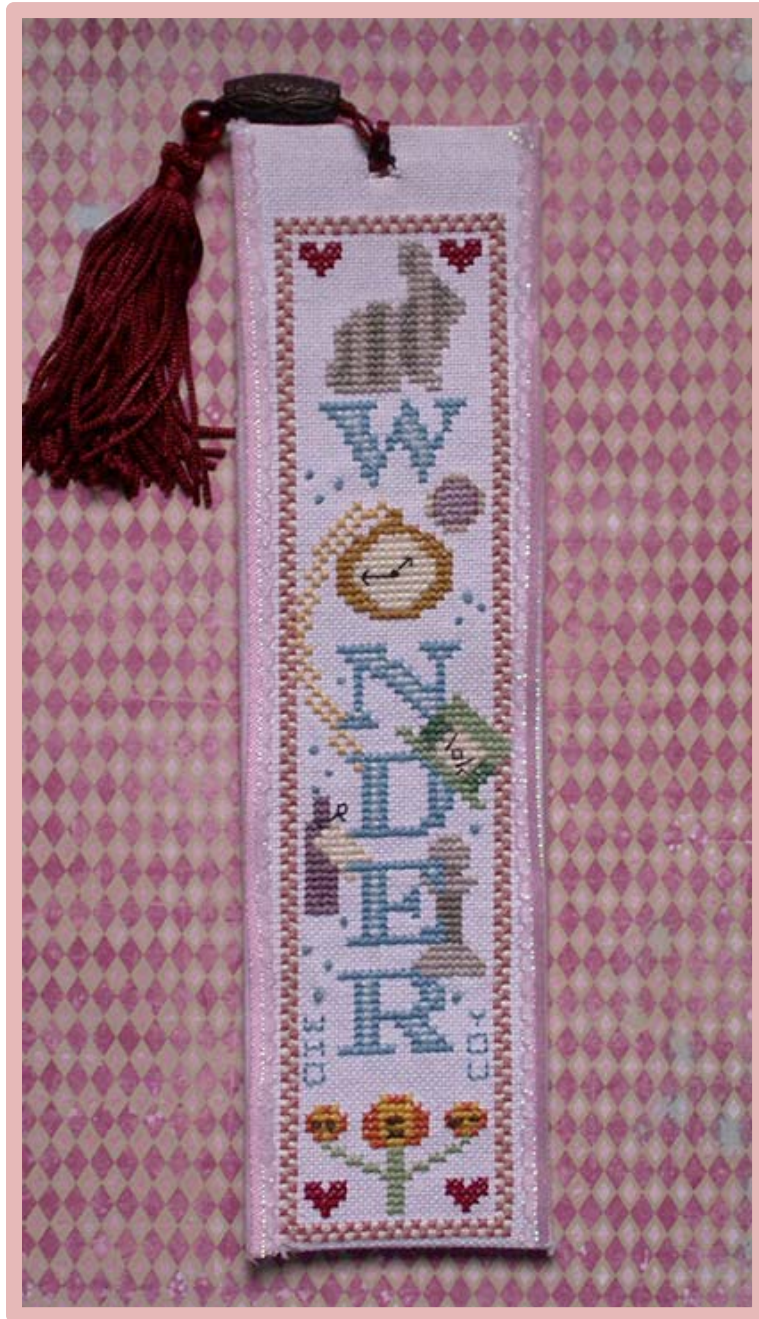
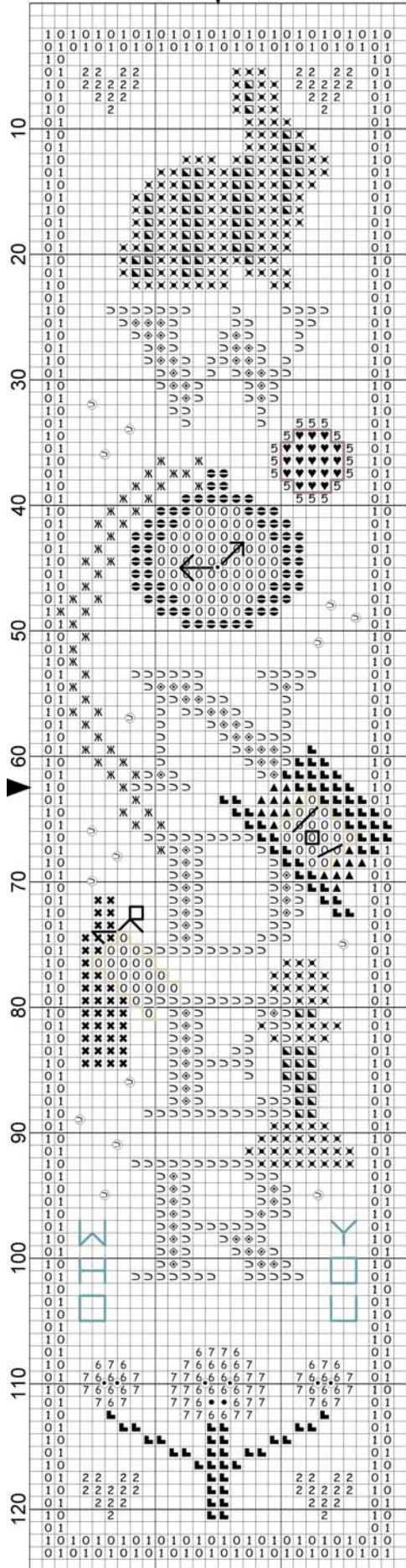

French Knots

DMC 310 - Eyes on the flowers and knot in the center of the watch.
 DMC 807 - All other knots.

Back Stitch

DMC 310 - Watch hands, numbers on hat and string on bottle.
 DMC 3041 - cookie (upper right of watch)
 DMC 807 - Words "who" and "you"
 DMC 613 - Label on bottle and on hat.

You will need the following items to stitch this bookmark:

Linen/Aida

White 32ct linen or 16 ct Aida

Finishing instructions

If you want your bookmark to look like the one in the model you will need the following items:

Scissors
Glue
Decorative paper
Tassel
Ribbon
Cardboard

Finishing Steps

- 1- Cut linen 1/2 to 1 inch on all sides. You will need enough to wrap around the cardboard and glue.
- 2- Cut Cardboard to match your stitched design.
- 3- Fold sides of linen around cardboard and glue. Do the sides first and then the top and bottom. This will make cleaner corners. If corners don't look perfect it's okay because they will be covered with ribbon.
- 4- Cut decorative paper to cover the back of the bookmark. Then glue it on.
- 5- Glue or sew ribbon to sides of the bookmark.
- 6- Punch hole in top and attach tassel.
